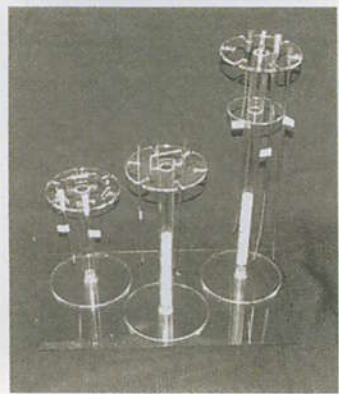
three styles to suit your feet and mobility; and FacEssentials headgear, which protects against frostbite and fastens with
